This is the first of our regular American Doubles Tournaments and with Scott at the helm, it is sure to be another fantastic event!

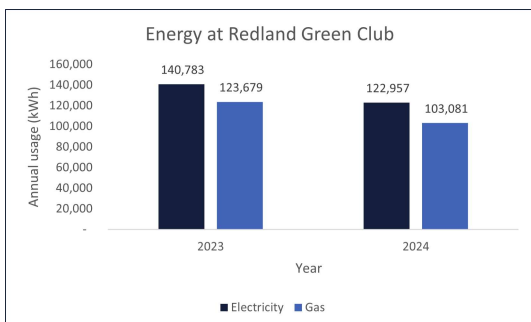

## Energy Saving

The sustainability group made great progress in 2024. We've seen a fantastic drop in our energy usage from 2023 to 2024. Our electricity consumption is down **12% overall**, with outdoor usage falling by an impressive **41%** thanks to our switch to energy-efficient LED floodlights. On the gas front, we've achieved a **16% reduction**, with early

improvements already showing from the roof insulation installed in September. There are lots more initiatives coming this year so we're excited to see what more we can do!
