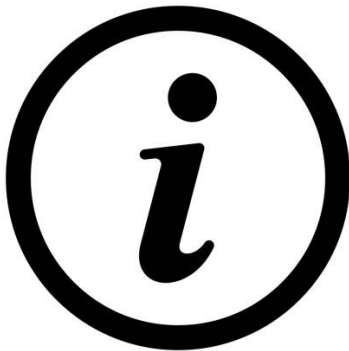

Development update



Our application of floodlighting and fencing for two new tennis courts on the grassed area to the rear of the clubhouse was submitted in 14/01/25 and validated on 24/02/25.

Neighbour consultation commenced on 04/03/25 and following the submission of revised drawings relocating the two proposed courts to the centre of the grassed area the neighbour consultation was recommenced on 28/03/25.

The consultation period expired on 18/04/25 and the architects are chasing the planning officer for feedback as the determination date was 21/04/25 and the status of the application remains 'pending consideration'.

The only consultee comment from Bristol City Council Pollution Control concluded that there was no objection to the floodlights, only that there should be a timer to switch floodlighting off at 10pm. There are currently 12 public comment objections and 2 in support. We will issue an update as soon as we receive feedback from the planning officer.
